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### **Recom Managed Systems to Initiate User Preference Studies for the 12-Lead, Wireless, Ambulatory ECG System**

LOS ANGELES—(BUSINESS WIRE)—July 22, 2004— Earlier today, Recom Managed Systems, Inc. (OTCBB:RECM - News) announced that it will be undertaking a “user preference study” under the supervision of a third party Institutional Review Board (“IRB”).

The purpose of the study will be to comparatively test Recom’s first generation device against existing ambulatory ECG systems using volunteer subjects. Recom believes this effort will demonstrate its superior ECG signal quality under a range of ambulatory/stress conditions and assist in the final production configuration of the Company’s first device.

Since receiving FDA marketing clearance for its first device earlier this year, the Company has been preparing for its upcoming product roll-out. The Company believes this study, to be conducted at the newly completed Recom product evaluation laboratory, will provide the Company with the comparative data needed to finalize user preference input and configurations as commercialization efforts are being finalized.

Marvin H. Fink, Recom’s CEO, stated, “This is an important step towards finalizing the design of our product and we hope the comparative data gathered utilizing Recom’s patented signal technology will assist in the Company’s upcoming marketing efforts. This is also an important precursor to the Company’s goal of performing clinical research studies in order to show that long-term ambulatory monitoring of patients using the Company’s devices may provide doctors with advanced warning of an upcoming cardiac event.”

Dr. Budimir S. Drakulic, Recom’s Chief Technical Officer, commented: “This is yet another milestone where we expect to achieve objective measurements of our system’s superior performance in ambulatory settings.”

The Recom ECG monitor system utilizes the company’s patented signal technology which produces a high fidelity ECG signal in the presence of ambient noise. This capability allows Ambulatory recording to become another source for diagnostic 12-lead ECG records on a par with other modalities such as resting ECG and exercise stress testing.
